



Accessing the new Concessions for Classics (C4C) scheme

You will need: -

- Current DOT licencing papers for your vehicle
- Your ASRF membership number

Visit <https://www.transport.wa.gov.au/licensing/concessions.asp> and click into the Concessions for Classics scheme. There is a small summary and several PDFs to download.

- Download and Read the Concessions for Classics scheme FAQ's
- Download C4C Form E116 and fill it out
- Download and Read the C4C code of conduct
- Download and print the C4C log book template including page 2

Visit the ASRFWA website <https://www.asrf.org.au/wa> and under forms, click on the Concessions for Classics Vehicle Registration. Fill in all the details and submit. You will receive a return email for your records.

Next, scan and email the DOT form E116 to asrfwa@gmail.com for authorisation by an ASRF certifying officer. This form (E116) will then be emailed back and then you can lodge it with DOT in the following ways: -

- Email: concessions@transport.wa.gov.au
- Post: Vehicle Services (concessions), Department of Transport, GPO R1290, Perth, WA 6844. -
- In Person: At a Driver and Vehicles (DVS) centre, DOT regional office or agent.

Please note it is the vehicle owner's responsibility to abide by the C4C Code of Conduct and ensure they are a full financial member of the approved motoring club (ASRFWA).
